

Create A Hyperlink

A useful tool is to have some text that if clicked, will take you immediately to another page on your web site or on the internet. You may wish to invite visitors to your web site to view the GDI presentation located at your “freedom” site. 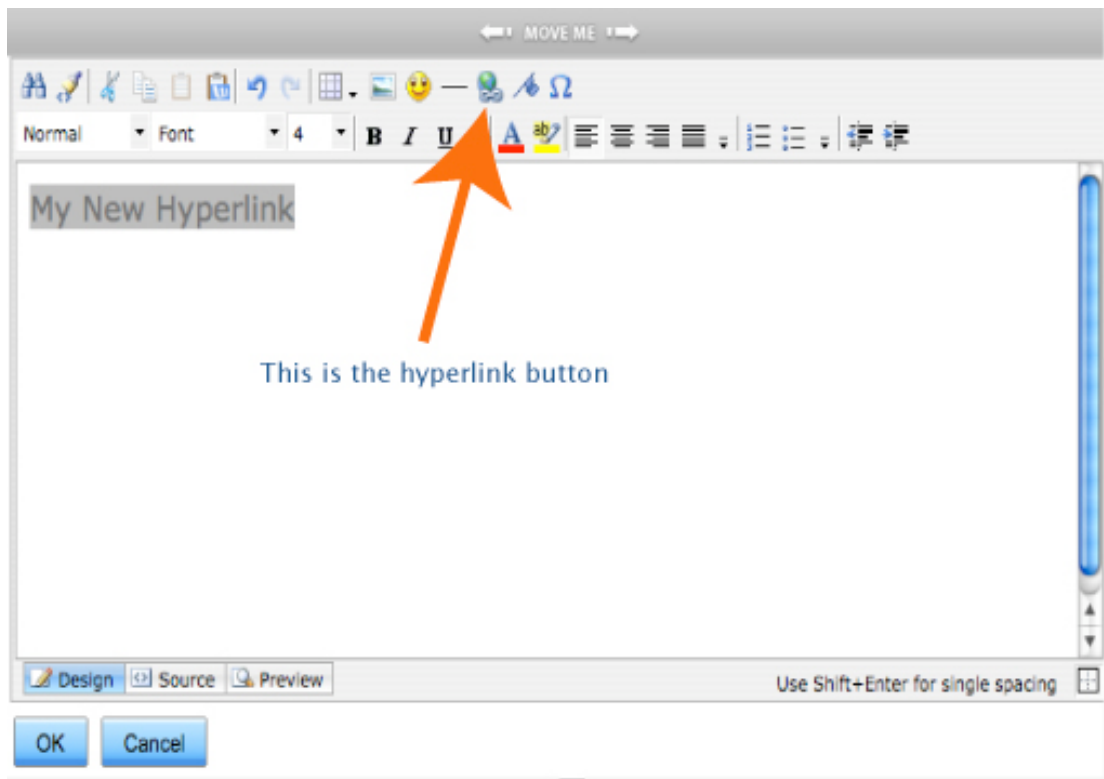
Of course you want them to be sent to **your** web site so that when they decide to sign up they go on your team - right?

So how do you do that ? It’s easy. E-S-P (Edit, Save, Publish)

Go to Site builder, edit the page you want, insert a hyperlink and tell it where to send the “clicker”

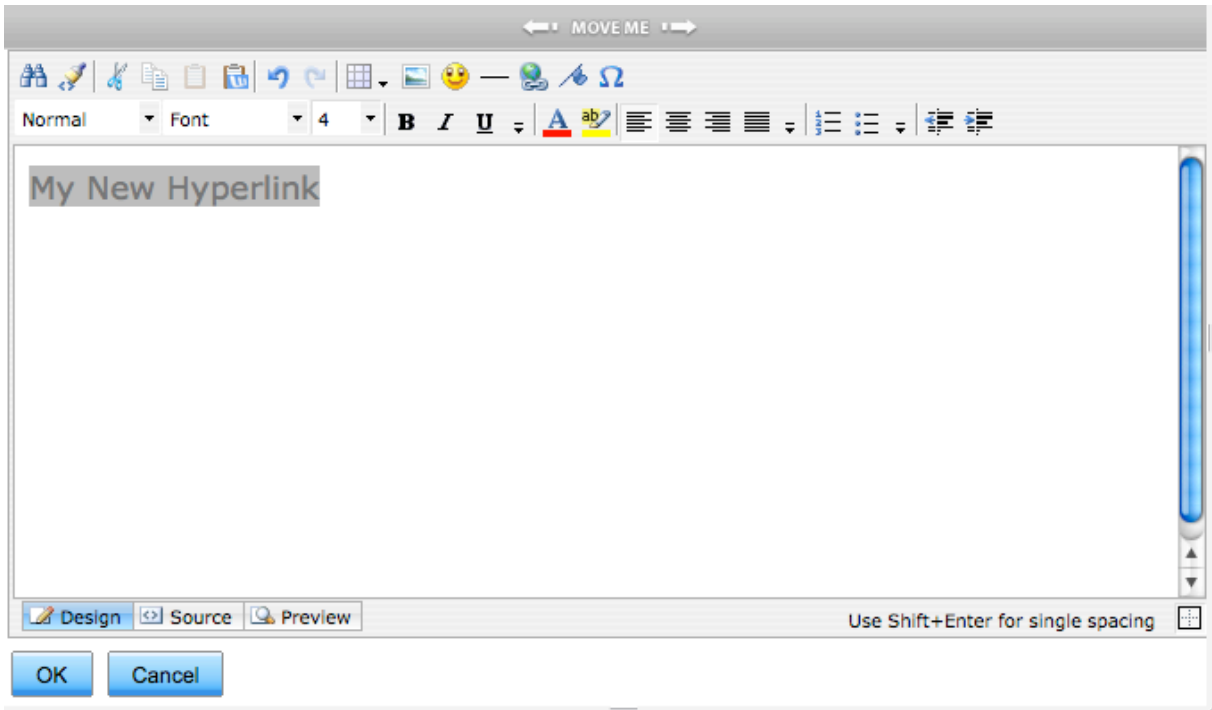
SPECIFICALLY:

- Go to www.website.ws
- > [My Account] Log In
 - > Build Your Website (WS Site Builder 4.01)
 - > Click [EDIT] on the page you want to place your hyperlink
 - > On your Tool Bar click on [TEXT]
 - > click on your page and you’ll be given a text box
 - > click on the hyperlink button

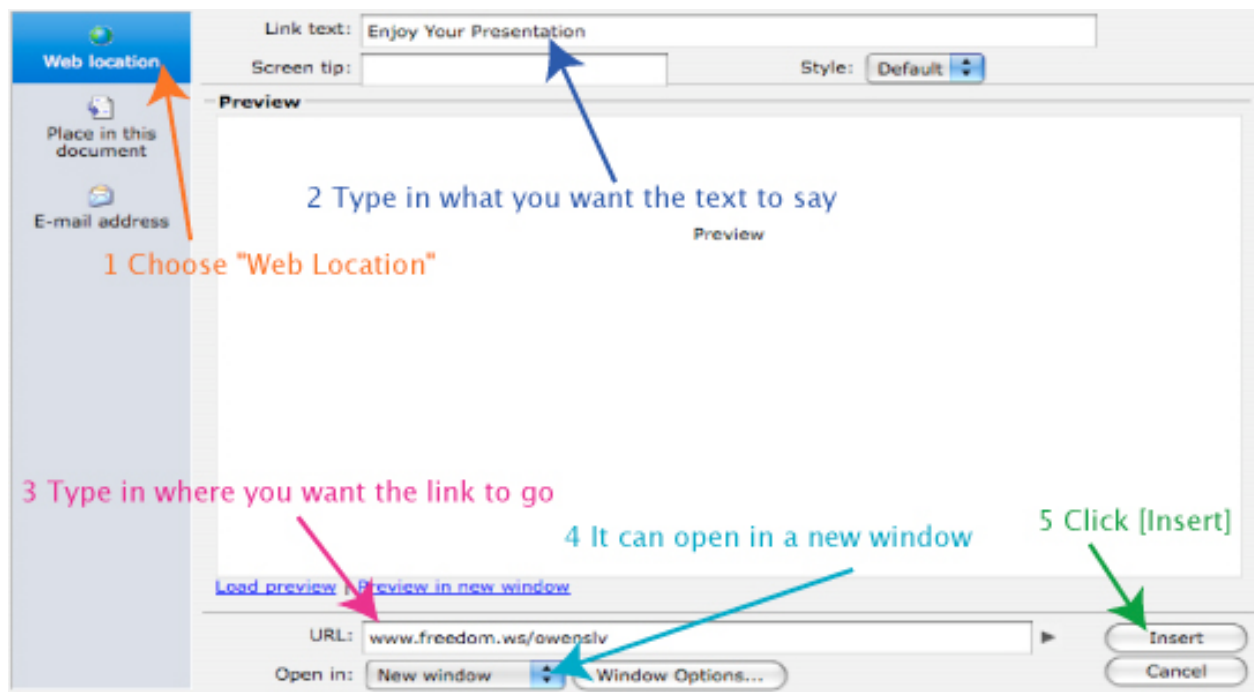


Create A Hyperlink

> You will be shown the hyperlink box



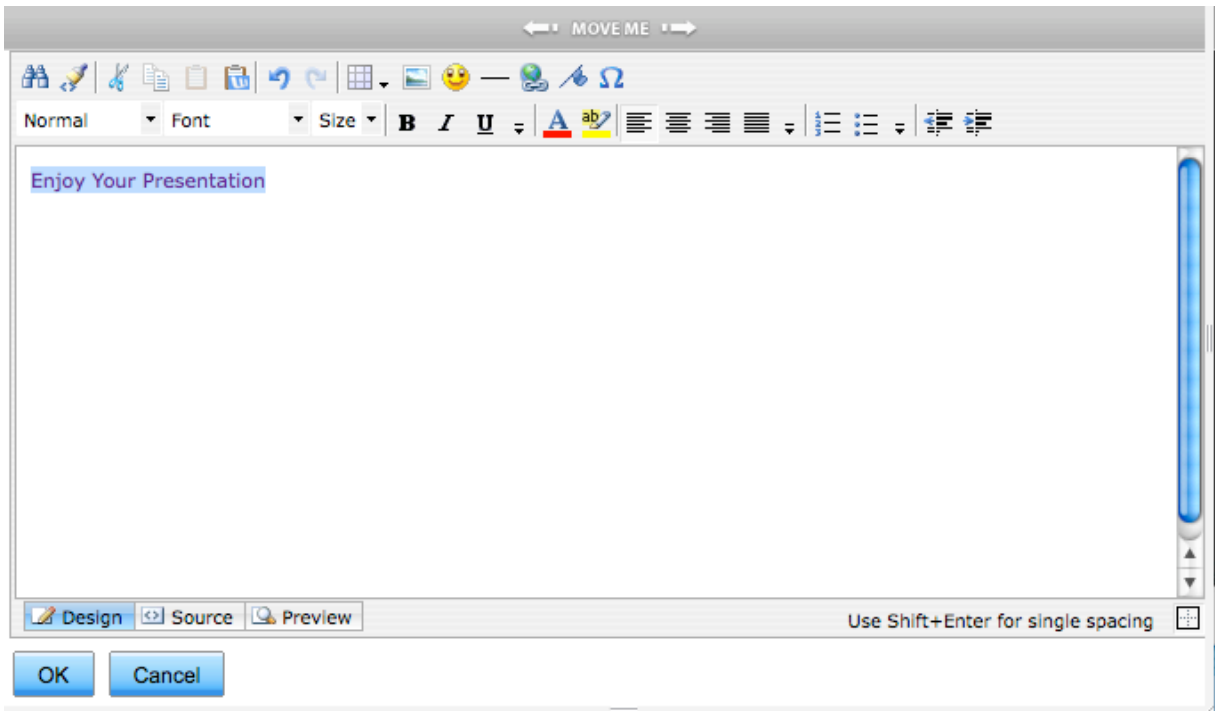
> Simply type in your options

Create A Hyperlink

> after you click [Insert] You'll get this screen



If you click on [Preview] you can see what it looks like and actually try it out.

Click OK when you are finished

- > Save (OK/Save)
- > Go Back (OK/Save)
- > and finally click on [Publish]
